

Dynamic Diamantes

A **diamante** (pronounced “dee-uh-mahn-tay”) is a seven-line diamond-shaped poem. It has rules for the number and types of words on each line.

Diamante Rules	Example Diamante
Line 1: One word - Noun	Cat
Line 2: Two words – Adjectives	Gentle, Sleepy
Line 3: Three words – Verbs	Purring, Meowing, Scratching
Line 4: Four words – Nouns	Whiskers, Fur, Collar, Leash
Line 5: Three words – Verbs	Barking, Licking, Digging
Line 6: Two words – Adjectives	Slobbery, Playful
Line 7: One word – Noun	Dog
