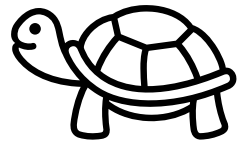




My Sloth Is Supersonic



Read this poem and answer the questions on the back

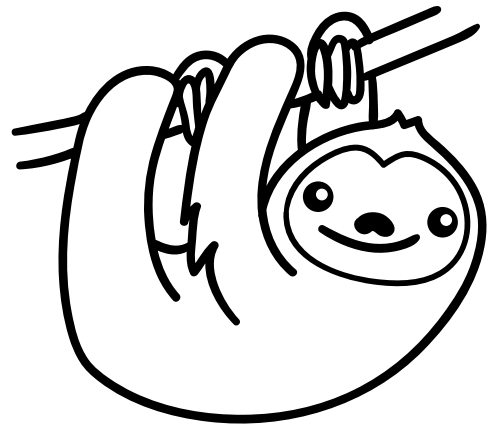
My sloth is supersonic

and turtle love to race.

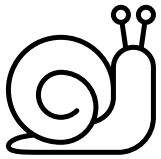
A week ago, my pets were slow,

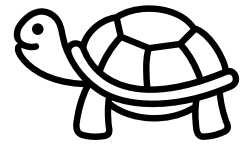
