

Our Teacher's a Football Fanatic

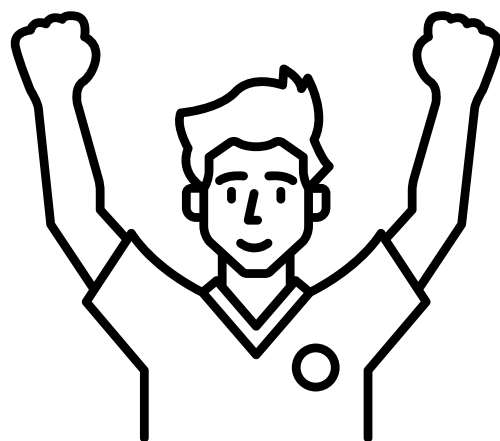
Read this poem. Then follow the instructions on the back.
