then I sleepily chewed.

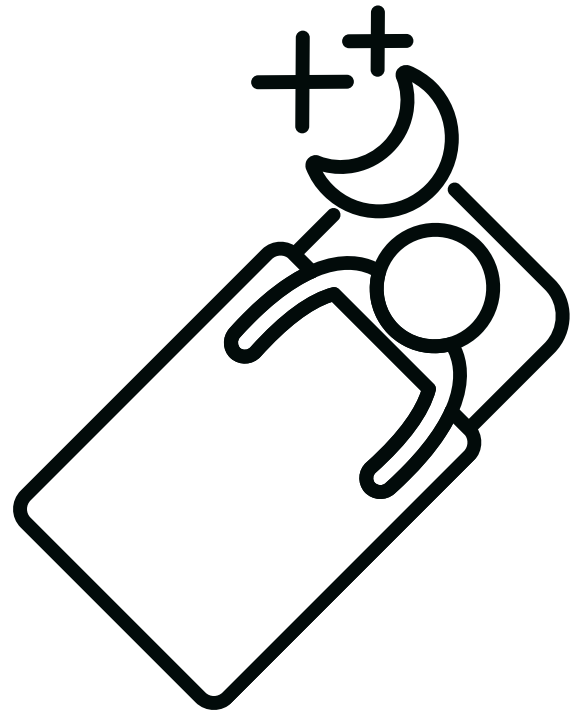
I picked up my books

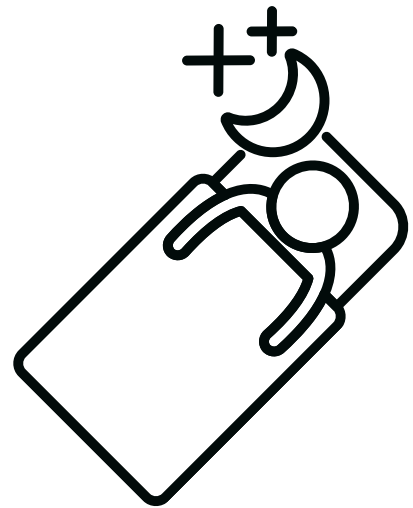
