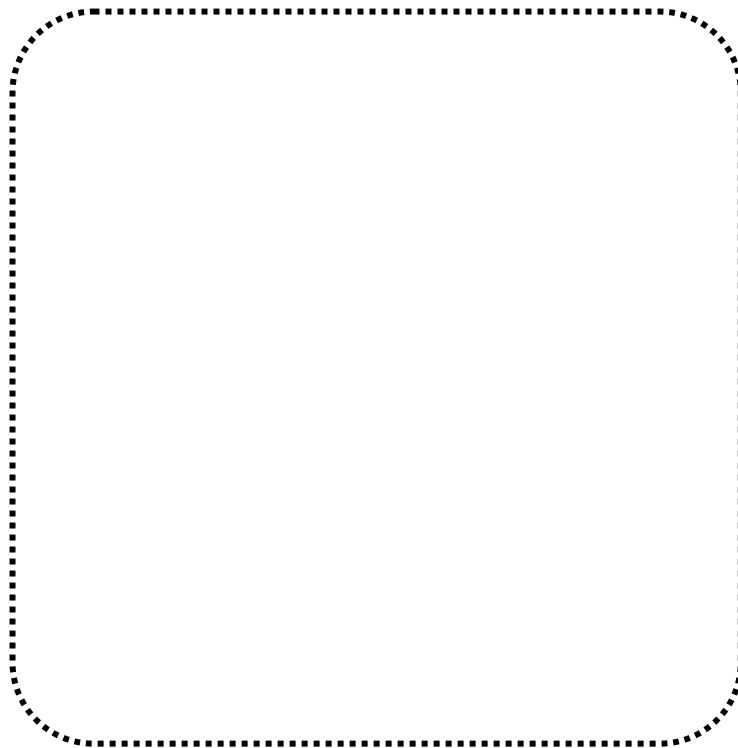


Here's a Silly Poem
