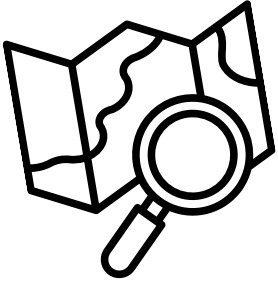
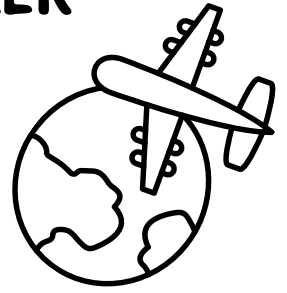


# MY SISTER SHOULD BE AN EXPLORER

and beaches for surfing the waves.

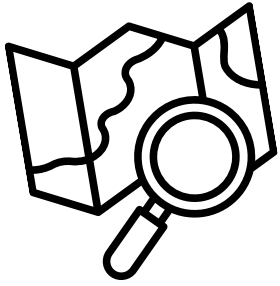
She'd journey through jungles and deserts.

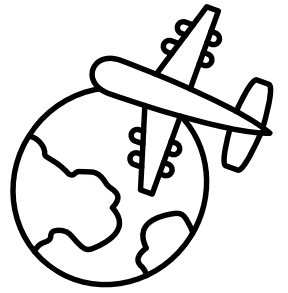
